He has made major contributions to the epidemiology & understanding cancer, blood groups and leprosy. He was the first to use FNAC for the diagnosis of neoplasms. He also played apivotal role in planning premier institutes in India including AIMS, New Delhi. He served as the first president of IAPM and Govt. of India conferred Padma Bhushan on him for his services in promoting medical research & education in 1955.

Pathology is the bridge between science and medicine, plays a major role in final diagnosis of diseases and has a crucial role in delivering high-quality medical care.





+ FIRST HAIR TRANSPLANTATION

Hair transplantation is safe and relatively painless procedure which restores and grows hair naturally.

It gives ultimate permanent remedy for baldness.

Hair transplantation procedure includes removal of hair from the back of the scalp (donor area) and transferred to the bald area (recipient area). The transplanted hair will have same features like the donor area. There are different types of techniques like FUE (Follicular Unit Extraction), FUT (Follicular Unit Transplantation and DHI (Direct Hair Implantation) that are used to do the hair transplantation.







At Akash Hospital, this procedure is done in a well-equipped operation theatre by a specialist. The procedure is day care procedure with no complications and minimal post-procedural care with the finest results.
